## WTSG COVID-19 REOPENING PLAN

First and foremost, WELCOME BACK!! We are so excited to begin the reopening process of the Wayne Township Senior Group!! Due to the government restrictions, things will be a bit different but we hope to have things set up so we can all enjoy a fun Wednesday lunchtime get together!

The Wayne Township Senior Group will reopen starting on Wednesday, September, 2nd at 11 am. with the following rules/restrictions in place:

- 1. 23 Meadowbrook Center will be cleaned and sanitized each Tuesday evening to get ready for the WTSG on Wednesday mornings. The building will again be sanitized after the WTSG meets.
- 2. All WTSG members and volunteers must follow CDC recommendations with regards to the wearing of masks and social distancing. Temperatures will be taken of everyone entering the building and staff will also wear gloves when checking members in and serving food.
- 3. The total number of people in the building at one time for the WTSG, including volunteers and members will not exceed 25 people. **Tables will be placed 6 feet apart and only one person will be allowed to sit at a table, with the exception of couples living in the same household.**
- 4. All WTSG members will be required to do the following each week they come:
  - a. Upon coming the first time, members will be required to complete and sign the "Center Reopening Guidelines for Individuals" which is available on-line.
  - b. When arriving at the center, members temperatures will be taken and they will be required to answer COVID-19 screening questions. If they have a temperature greater than 100.4 or answer "yes" to any of the questions, they will not be allowed to participate that day and will be directed to the appropriate health professionals.
- 5. All members are asked to use hand sanitizer when entering and exiting the building.
- 6. Members will be required to wear a mask when coming in the facility, walking to their table or going to the restroom. Masks can be off while eating lunch or playing Bingo, but must be put back on when they get up from their table.
- 7. Members are only allowed to bring 1 personal item with them (purse, etc.). No mugs, shopping bags, etc. will be allowed to be brought in the building
- 8. Any coat/scarf/outerwear will be placed on the back of their chair coat rack will not be used.
- 9. Members are not allowed to bring food to share and they are not allowed to share the food provided to them by the Center.
- 10. Members must remain seated at their table unless they need to use the restroom. No moving of tables or chairs from their pre-set locations.
- **11.** *BINGO* will be played after lunch each week using disposable cards and daubers that can be sanitized
  - a. When a member calls Bingo, they will be asked to read off their own cards to prove they have all the necessary winning numbers.
  - b. Prizes will be provided by the Center, members should NOT bring anything with them for prizes.
  - c. Bingo prizes will be delivered to the winners by 1 designated volunteer wearing gloves.
